Blended Learning – Schedule & Guidelines

- Approximately 50% of the students will report on Monday & Tuesday and the other 50% will report on Thursday & Friday.
- On days students are not on campus, they are to be working virtually through Schoology. Those given assignments WILL COUNT toward their final grade for that grading period.
- Each student will be provided a laptop/tablet to complete any assignments given. Those devices will be issued prior to their return to school.

Blended Learning – Schedule & Guidelines

- Faculty, staff, & student body will practice proper social distancing each day they attend and will wear face coverings/masks whenever proper social distancing protocols cannot be maintained.
- Per county policy, students need to make sure they are arriving on time to school each day and are in each class on time to maximize learning.
- Attendance will be taken daily in each class and student participation will be monitored via Schoology on days students do not attend and are to be working from home.

Virtual Learning Schedule & Guidelines

- Students will receive their instruction & class assignments through Schoology and Microsoft Teams. Microsoft Teams will be the platform used to video chat for class instruction.
- Students will be required to complete ALL assignments delivered virtually through these platforms.
- Students will receive a grade on ALL assignments given.
- Student participation will be monitored & reviewed daily by the teacher assigned to them.
- At the end of each grading period (6 weeks), students will have the option to withdraw from Virtual Learning and go into the Blended Learning schedule.

Wednesdays (Faculty & Staff report only)

- No students will report on Wednesdays. Teachers will be able to work on lesson plans & have scheduled meetings with parents and/or students.
- Meetings will need to be scheduled prior to Wednesday. If parent/student need to meet with a teacher, please email that teacher or send a message through Schoology.
- Virtual meetings with teachers will be the preferred method to meet with teachers. If an in-person meeting is needed, please schedule in advance prior to Wednesday.
- Additional cleaning measures will be taken on Wednesdays on top of normal cleaning & sanitization protocols.

Meal Pickup Guidelines

- Wednesdays will be utilized for meal pickups.
- To enroll for the meal pickup service, you must sign up on wayneschoolswv.org, then click on the purple tab labeled “Meal Service Enrollment (SY 20-21)” located at the top of the county website.
- The time frame each Wednesday to pick up the meals will be between 11:30 – 12:30 in at the school cafeteria located next the school gymnasium.
- You will pull up next to the specified area and the meals will be brought out to you so that you can remain in your vehicle (curbside service).

COVID-19 Information

- If a student tests positive for COVID-19 or has any of the following symptoms (temperature at or above 100.4, chills, shortness or breath/difficulty breathing, loss of taste and/or smell, new cough), they will not be allowed to return to school until they have met the following conditions
 - No fewer than 10 days following the first sign of symptoms
 - No less than 3 days from the time the student had a fever (without medicine)
 - No less than 3 days since the student's symptoms improved , which include coughing & shortness of breath.
- If a student has come within close contact with anyone who is positive for COVID 19 or been told to quarantine by a medical professional, they must remain at home.
- Once the student has received a negative COVID-19 test and/or has received a statement from a doctor allowing the student to return, they may return after going 24 hours feeling well & without a fever (with no fever-reducing medicine)

COVID 19 Monitoring & Screening

- Faculty, staff, & students will be temperature checked & answer screening questions daily upon arrival to school.
- At any point and time should a student show symptoms or feel sick at school, they will be placed in a designated isolation room until that person is picked up.

Social Distancing Guidelines

- Faculty, staff, & students must maintain social distancing requirement of 6 feet apart with each other when possible.
- Markings will be placed throughout the schools (hallways, cafeteria, etc.) to ensure & maintain proper social distancing.
- During class changes, students will move in a single file line down the hallways and follow the markers that are placed throughout the school
- Seating charts for classrooms and buses will be made
- Student arrival & dismissal at school will be monitored to discourage congregating
- Nonessential visitors will be limited. Meetings & communications will be encouraged to take place as often as possible by phone or video conference.

Mask Guidelines

- Masks/face coverings will be worn by all faculty/staff when they cannot provide instruction in a socially distanced (6 ft) manner.
- Students will be required to wear masks/face coverings whenever proper social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Two cloth masks will be provided each semester to students, but students are allowed to bring and wear their own masks/face coverings.
- Masks/face coverings are required when on school buses.

Health & Wellness Protocols and Supports

- Handwashing stations will be placed at all designated school entrances.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided and available in each classroom.
- Cups will be made available at all water fountains.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles or other container (also encouraged to put their name on it)
- Classroom doors will be open as often as possible to lessen the touching of doors & door handles
- Classroom windows are encouraged to be open as often as possible

School Cleanliness

- Custodial staff will clean & disinfect heavily traveled areas (hallways, restrooms, etc.) and commonly used items multiple times throughout the day. Teachers will also be wiping down desks, tables, etc. in their classrooms between classes.
- School buses will be cleaned & disinfected daily before each run (morning & evening). Bus windows will be left open whenever possible.
- Gym equipment; materials in CTE, Art, Music, etc. that are shared will be cleaned between uses.

Cafeteria Protocols & Guidelines

- Tables & chairs will be cleaned and disinfected after each lunch period.
- Students must maintain proper social distancing (6 feet) while in the cafeteria lines and spaced apart at tables while eating in the cafeteria.
- Milk coolers will remain locked and cartons will be handed to students.
- Salad bar & fruits will not be placed on the carts.
- Condiments will be placed on food trays when students get meals.
